Section 508 Compliance

NEC Display Solutions responds to Notice of Section 508 Accessibility, Title V of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended under the Workforce Investment Act, requiring Federal Agencies to make their electronic and IT accessible to disabled employees and members of the public.

Implemented of the standards, as developed by the Access Board (www.accessboard.gov) along with technical assistance from the General Services Administration (GSA), was conducted under the establishment of an interagency initiative known as Federal IT Accessibility Initiative (FITAI) in order to assist all Federal Agencies in meeting the Section 508 requirements. NEC Display Solutions supports Federal agencies as they implement Section 508 and deploy accessible systems. This commitment covers all NEC Display Solutions branded display monitor products offered directly to the Government by NEC Display Solutions as well as sales made by our resellers and integrators. At the core of this commitment is the use of a standardized template made available by the Information Technology Industry Council (ITI), on their website at: www.itic.org . The information is linked to GSA sponsored Accessibility Forum which is an industry-led partnership among people with disabilities, EIT vendors, and assistive technology vendors. The Voluntary Product Accessibility Template developed by ITIC is utilized by NEC Display Solutions and follows the specific Criteria as outlined in detail under the Federal Register, Part II, Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board, 36 CFR, Part 1194, Electronic and Information Technology Accessibility Standards, Final Rule, dated December 21, 2000. The following Sections (or elements of these Sections) may apply to NEC Display Solutions monitor display products when used as an integral component of a configured system which, generally, are reliant upon the computer, operating system, and software commands. In summary, the following accessibility criteria apply and are met by all NEC Display Solutions products:

- _ One-handed operation of controls and keys
- Twisting, pinching, grasping require less than 5 pounds pressure
- Controls and keys visually and tactilely discernible, including locking status, as
 Applicable (For large format displays this is achieved through the remote control
 Industry standard ports and connectors
- _ Do not have a screen flicker with a frequency greater than 2 Hz, whereby our minimum frequency support is at 55 Hz and can range as high as 160 Hz Documentation will be provided in accessible format, Upon request
- For large format displays with tuners closed captioning is also provided.
